- Download ring tones

NOKIA 2115i

1 Check it out!

- 1 Power key**
Press and hold to turn phone on or off.
Press and release to switch profiles.
- 2 Integrated flashlight**
Illuminates objects. Alerts you to incoming calls.
- 3 Two-way scroll key** 
From the start screen, press the scroll key to:
View My Balance
Access your Contacts
- 4 Selection keys** 
Press to select the option shown on the screen above the key.
From the start screen, the left selection key accesses the Menu,
and the right selection key accesses your Contacts.
- 5 Call key** 
Dials a number. Answers a call. Shows recent calls made.
- 6 End key** 
Ends a call. Rejects an incoming call.
Returns to the start screen from any feature.
- 7 Handsfree speaker**
Press the right selection key to talk handsfree during a call.
- 8 Pop-Port™ connector**
For headsets, data cables, and other Nokia enhancements.



2 Handy, built-in flashlight.










The Nokia 2115i phone features a handy, built-in flashlight to illuminate objects, guide you in the dark, and alert you to incoming calls.

You can activate the flashlight when the phone is in standby mode or during a call. You cannot, however, activate the flashlight while navigating the menu options.

Activate the flashlight

Press and hold the * key to activate the flashlight. The flashlight will stay active until you release the * key.

Use the flashlight to alert you to an incoming call

1. Press the left selection key to select *Menu*. ()
2. Press the scroll down key to scroll to and select *Settings* (fig. 2.1). () ()
3. Scroll to and select *Tone settings* (fig. 2.2). () ()
4. Scroll to and select *Light alert* (fig. 2.3). () ()
5. Scroll to and select *On* (fig. 2.4). () ()

The light will now flash to alert you to an incoming call when you use this profile.

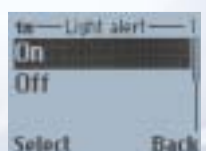

3 Look—no hands!

Your Nokia 2115i phone lets you have a conversation while you're working at your desk, eating a meal, or making coffee!

Why not invite other people in the room to join the conversation?

Use the handsfree feature

1. Press the scroll down key to access *Contacts*. (⌵)
2. Scroll to the person you want to call (fig. 3.1). (⌵)
3. Press the call key (📞)
4. When *Loudsp.* is displayed on the screen press the right selection key to select it. You can hear the number ringing and you can speak handsfree during the call (fig. 3.2). (⏪)
5. If you want to deactivate the speakerphone during the call, press the right selection key to select *Handset* (fig. 3.3). (⏪)

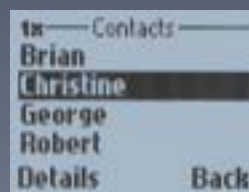

4 Personalize your ring tone.

Download your favorite music from the Internet and use it as your ring tone! You can change and update your ring tone as often as you want. The MIDI format guarantees excellent sound quality.

Save a ring tone

1. The screen displays *Ring tone received* after downloading a ring tone (fig. 4.1).
2. Press the left selection key to select *Save sound*. (⏩)

Set your default ring tone

1. Select *Menu*. (⏩)
2. Scroll to and select *Settings* (fig. 4.2). (⌵) (⏩)
3. Scroll to and select *Tone settings*. (⌵) (⏩)
4. Scroll to and select *Ring tone*, and select the tone you want (fig. 4.3). (⌵) (⏩)

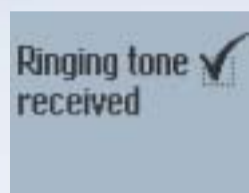

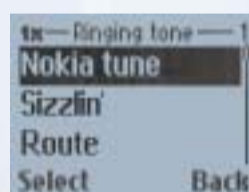
